









# Call for Applications for Pedagogical Innovation Projects at NOVA FCT – 2025

The NOVA FCT Management Council announces the opening of the application period for the Pedagogical Innovation Projects program, according to the current regulations.

## 1. Application Period

From July 1st to July 21st, 2025.

## 2. Objective

To financially support the implementation of pilot projects in pedagogical innovation during the fall or summer semester of the 2025/2026 academic year, promoting the enhancement of the teaching and learning experience, faculty professional development, and the consolidation of a culture of pedagogical innovation at NOVA FCT.

## 3. Eligible Applicants

Faculty members and researchers at NOVA FCT with teaching responsibilities in course units of the 1st, 2nd, or 3rd cycles are eligible to apply.

#### 4. Funding

- The funding per project is 1000 euros.
- Up to 7 proposals will be funded.
- At least 4 of the selected projects must focus on 1st-year course units.

#### 5. Preference

Preference will be given to applications focusing on 1st-year curricular units, as a strategic measure to support student transition and integration into higher education, within the scope of the project "SUCCESS@NOVA – Strategies to Underpin College Course Engagement and Student Success".

## 6. Submission

## 7. Required Documentation

Completed application form which includes:

- Project title, objectives, impact and description
- Activity plan and methodology
- Timeline
- Strategy for evidence collection
- Detailed and justified budget
- Identification of the proponent(s) and collaborators
- Other funding sources (if available)
- Declaration of responsibility

### 8. Evaluation and Results

Applications will be evaluated by a panel appointed by the Management Council, based on the criteria defined in the regulations.

Results will be communicated by email and published through NOVA FCT's institutional channels.
